



HOW CAN I GET ASSISTANCE TO HELP WITH TUITION COSTS?

Tuition assistance will be available for all families affected by the new tuition policy, even if you do not qualify for a CHOICE scholarship. The administration will work with you to secure assistance from the following sources.

CHOICE Scholarships

The CHOICE Scholarship Program's new guidelines allow many more families to qualify for a voucher that will cover most – or even all – of your tuition. Many of you may not even realize that you qualify for this incredible benefit! The income guidelines below will let you know if you are eligible for a CHOICE scholarship.

Income Eligibility Based on Household Size for the 2023-2024 School Year

If your 2022 federal income tax Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) is at or below the income limit for your household size, you qualify for an SGO or School Choice Voucher for the 2023-2024 school year.

These numbers will be adjusted for inflation for the 2024-2025 school year and will be based on your 2023 federal income tax Adjusted Gross Income (AGI).

Parish Tuition Assistance

If you are not eligible for CHOICE – or if the CHOICE scholarship does not cover your full tuition – substantial help is available from the parish. **All families with any concerns about tuition are encouraged to apply for assistance.** The school administration will then work with you individually to create an assistance package that will work for your family.

NEXT STEPS

1. **All families must complete a FACTS Form (<https://online.factsmgt.com/aid>),** which is required for CHOICE Scholarships and Parish Tuition Assistance. We recommend completing the FACTS Form as soon as you have your 2022 tax returns and W-2's.
2. Look at the CHOICE income guidelines to determine if you might be eligible for a CHOICE scholarship.
